Under Tree Schools, our charity of the month

Our girls' school in South Sudan is meeting a great demand. This year there are 320 primary pupils, and in addition 28 of our girls have now gone on to secondary school, with our help to pay their fees.

The recent civil war is formally over. But much of the country is still dangerous, including the area the school is in. And the war (and corruption in Government) has bankrupted the country. It is wonderful that our friend Revd Joseph Ayok-Loewenberg now heads their Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and can bring influence to bear on future Government policy.
