Charity of the week: Church Urban Fund

The proceeds of the Carol Service go, as in past years, to the Church Urban Fund. The Fund was set up by the Church of England 30 years ago. Currently it has three national programmes, to bring about sustainable change: it helps local communities address hate and prejudice by encouraging different communities to work together to meet local needs; it helps communities ensure that everyone has a safe place to go to find a friendly face, a cup of tea and a conversation; and it helps communities tackle the distress caused by unmanageable personal debt through setting up local support services.

St Mary's Christmas Fair: All the money taken by our Christmas Fair has now been gathered in and the grand total is £6891. This is a superb result and represents an outstanding effort by many of our people who brought their creativity and commercial nous to the enterprise. Special thanks go to Louise Thompson who co-ordinated the Fair. Richard and the PCC would like to express their thanks to everyone involved.
