### Feast of Baroque Concert to celebrate HM Queen's 90th Birthday Sunday 19th June 2016 at 6pm

St Mary's Combined Choirs will perform Handel's Zadok and Vivaldi's Gloria accompanied by period instruments. The concert is in aid of the church's Music Fund which supports scholarships for sixth-form musicians who aspire to choral and organ awards at university. Director of Music at St Mary's, Daniel Turner said "preparing these wonderfully rhetorical works is so good for a choir like St Mary's as they have to live every word and note. The choristers must express the dance-like rhythms and sheer exuberance of this style of music and working with baroque instrumentalists means their sound and articulation really brings out the dynamism of the musical writing."
