Our charity over Christmas: the Church Urban Fund

The collection at the Carol Service will be donated to the Church Urban Fund. This charity was launched by the Church of England in 1987 to tackle poverty in England's poorest communities. CUF gives grants to local projects, to help those struggling with food poverty, spiralling debts, homelessness and isolation. It funds community development, it seeks to bring together people from diverse communities, and it seeks to tackle financial injustice. By last year it had awarded £80 million to social action projects around the country.

Memorial Window: After much planning and many delays the 1215 Memorial Window has been installed in the Langton Chapel. This commemorates the sealing of Magna Carta and our connection with it through the visit of Archbishop Stephen Langton to St Mary's on his return to London from Runnymede. We celebrated the 800th anniversary of this event in 2015.

We shall be planning a special event to celebrate this important new addition to the fabric of our historic and beautiful church. Many thanks to those who have worked hard to get this project from conception through to completion.
