Our Charity of the moment - Castelnau Community Centre

This slot has been telling you about the important community development work the Centre in Stillingfleet Road has been doing with the people in North Barnes. It benefits children, young people, families and older people, and has created a community for those who have lacked one. 800 different people came into the Centre last year.

The Centre needs a new Chair of Trustees. They need us in St Mary's congregation to find them one. A suitable sort of person might have been a trustee of another charity at some point or had some management experience. She or he would have a little time to spare to keep in touch with the full time Director, Simon Roach, who runs the Centre with 8 part time staff. The Chair of Trustees will organise and chair at least 4 meetings of the 12 trustees per year, and ensure (with advice) that company and charity law are complied with.
