BISHOP'S LENT CALL 2017

A message from the Bishop of Southwark:

"For many years, the Bishop of Southwark's Lent Call has raised money for projects within our own Diocese and further afield. In 2016 we were able to give grants totalling over £80,000 to our Link Dioceses in Zimbabwe, projects in the Holy Land which we visited during the Diocesan Pilgrimage in Lent and to projects that work with people in our Diocese. As we spend time in prayer and contemplation this Lent I hope that you will feel able to generously support the projects we are supporting in or Link Dioceses in Zimbabwe and locally in the Diocese of Southwark." Over the next few weeks of Lent we will be highlighting these projects and a plate for donations will be at the back of the church.

The **Annual Parochial Church Council** is to be held on Thursday 27th April at 7.30pm. It's the time when we look back on the events and achievements of the past year and look ahead. We are looking for four new members for the Church Council (PCC). and we would very much like to hear from anyone who would be interested to offer their time in this way. Patty Darke is standing down as Churchwarden this year so offers for that role are also welcome. There is a poster at the back of church marked WANTED which gives more information.

We are very pleased to announce that next year there will be a **Parish Pilgrimage to the Holy Land**. This will be led by Rev'd Richard and a local guide. The dates are 6^{th} – 15^{th} February. We need to know names of those interested before Easter so please do give this careful thought and speak to Richard if you want to know more. There are leaflets explaining the programme which outlines the itinerary. The cost is £1925 per person for a twin-bedded shared room with private facilities. There is a £475 supplement for any who wants to book a single room. We need to be a group of no less than 15 but can be double that size.

Free Piano Recital: Anthony Hewitt (professional) and Alistair McGowan (amateur) join forces again for a third evening of varied and varying piano pleasure at St Mary's on April 3rd at 7.30pm. Alistair (Anthony's hard-working pupil) will again play a small selection of short pieces by: Schubert, Philip Glass, Mompou, Field, Debussy, Tchaikovsky and Grieg before Anthony saves the day with a performance of Mussorgsky's 'Pictures at an Exhibition.' Just bring yourselves. And a friend. Duration 75 mins approx.
