Under Tree Schools is a charity based in Charmouth, Dorset helping a community in Malek Alel, in rural South Sudan to grow into a self-sustaining and thriving place for families. We want to provide a good future for the town that was shattered by the civil war for the best part of 50 years. Now that there is peace again and families are returning to their homes, education for the girls will help lift their community out of subsistence and bring them a better life. With the referendum in 2011 overwhelmingly voting for a new, independent South Sudan, the education of young people in general and girls in particular has taken on an even greater importance. By providing them with a sound education it means that, as adults, they can help the new country stand on its own feet.
