#### Under Tree Schools, our charity of the month

The school is now in its eighth year. About 350 girls start each year, aged 6 to 15. Some fall out during the year, or during their school career, as parents need them at home or in the fields. But all of them have got some sense of formal education. Some of them have made it all the way to year 8, at age 15 - about a dozen a year on average.

And really excitingly 28 of them so far have gone on to secondary school, thanks to the encouragement the school gives them (and UTS's contribution to the fees they pay). So they are well on the way to getting the qualifications they need to get jobs - they will be among the first girls in South Sudan to be able to start careers.

Joseph Ayok's vision is bearing fruit.

New Parent/Toddler Group: We are starting a new group for Parents & Toddlers called St Mary's Minis which will meet every Thursday morning in term time from 10am – 11.15am in Kitson Hall. We have a lovely large space to use and lots of good toys for different ages of children. We also want to give the parents (or carers) a really good experience too so there will be croissants and good quality coffee. During the session there will be a short story-time worship slot in which we can share Bible stories and songs. We will charge just £2 per child to cover refreshment costs. everything. But we need a good team of volunteers to help to run the sessions on a rota basis and we hope that members of St Mary's congregation will help to do this.
