Capability Landscapes: To mark the tercentenary of the birth of Lancelot 'Capability' Brown in 1716, an innovative photographic print exhibition is taking place at St Mary's Barnes in the second half of November. At the launch on Tuesday 15th November at 6.30pm (admission free), Barnes parishioner Alasdair Saunders will explain how Lancelot Brown changed the face of eighteenth century England, designing country estates and mansions, moving hills and making flowing lakes and serpentine rivers, a magical world of green. The exhibition illustrates through photography and print many of the well-known Capability Brown landscapes including Blenheim, Burghley, Petworth and Croome Park. All are invited to the launch and to the exhibition which is open every morning from 10.30 to 12.30 until 26th November with free admission.
